This ensures that sounds from machinery such as table saws are kept within designated workspaces without causing any disruptions in the conference rooms.

The Teknion Expansion Cityline workstations are designed to meet the needs of a diverse and dynamic workplace, much like a modern city. With the aim of creating neighborhoods or team zones, these workstations promote activity and movement while also facilitating privacy and focus when needed.
