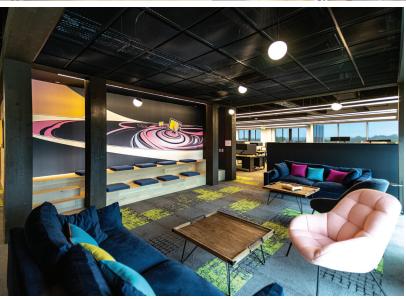

The workplace, which spans two levels, features an open-plan layout that incorporates a versatile double-height gathering space called the Townhall. The furnishings throughout the space include a range of seating options, from benches to swings to lounge chairs, geared to allow different group sizes to collaborate and socialize.

To facilitate communication and collaboration amongst the various work areas, the office includes a variety of social spaces, lounges, and meeting rooms.
